2024 Tri-State Area Youth Baseball League

League Specific Rules by Division- Coach Pitch Age 6-8

Little League rules will be followed in addition to the following:

- 1. At the beginning of the game both head coaches will meet to discuss these rules, review bats (USA stamped), and any issues related to the field, out of play areas etc.
- 2. All players need to be in the batting lineup all game. Only 10 players will play the field, but all players remain in the batting lineup. (For example: if you have 14 kids, all 14 are in the batting lineup all game and only 10 will play the field). Each player must play the field at least 2 innings.
- 3. 8 pitches or 3 strikes. If the 8th pitch is fouled, then batter will continue to bat until a ball is put into play or 3rd strike is made.
- 4. Batted ball hits the pitching coach the ball is declared dead and 1 base is given. No bunts or infield fly rule.
- 5. An attempt to get the ball back to the pitcher's circle (thrown ball crosses the line of the pitcher's circle) stops play (Pitcher's circle has an 8-foot radius)
- 6. Any ball batted into the infield (not hit to the grass of outfield) will result in a max of two bases advanced by runners.
- 7. Players in the Pitcher position **must wear a heart guard**. Player in Pitcher position must be at the back half of the pitcher's circle on either side of the coach with an unobstructed view of the batter.
- 8. No infielder may move closer to home plate than the back of the pitcher's circle prior to the ball being hit in play.
- 9. Catchers will play in full protective gear.
- 10. Halfway marks will be used to determine runner advancement as ball is returned to pitcher. A line will be placed halfway between first and second, halfway between second and third and three-quarters between third and home.
- 11. Only two players may have a bat in their hands during play. The batter and the on-deck batter provided the on-deck batter can be in a safe area within the field of play (inside the fence). No other players should have a bat, and no bats should be swung outside the field of play fence.
- 12. Game length No inning will start play after the 1:45 hour mark (inning will finish play if started before the 1:45-hour mark)
- 13. Six run limit per inning (plus continuation runs if runners present) <u>Unlimited runs in 6th inning only.</u>
- 14. 10 run mercy rule after four innings.
- 15. All teams should exhibit good sportsmanship (coaches and parents included). No negative chants, and no chants once the pitcher is ready to deliver the pitch.
- 16. In case of rain out the visiting team's coach should be notified 90 minutes before scheduled play.
